**More engagement:** Since June 2016, when I first took office, more Midwest Regioners have become part of committees – people who have not participated before.

**Feline Nines program:** Reinstated - since February 2017, more than 15 exhibitors have received \$50 or more for participating in Midwest Region shows.

**All inclusive:** The 2017 Midwest Regional Show and banquet was in a location that is central for Midwest Region exhibitors and showed that you don't have to have a club in a town to host a successful show. The regional show returns to Coralville lowa again in 2020.

**Welcoming**: As each new exhibitor is identified, they are personally welcomed into the region by Mary.

**Clerking school:** The region wants more - tentatively scheduled for February in conjunction with Lincoln State show.
